

Prospera INWF Data Highlights - 2021-2022



An overview of the 2021-2022 Women's and Feminist Funds figures.

Our Growing Network:

- # of Prospera members: 49 as of September 2024
 - # of Funds for 2022 data: 44 in 2022 reporting data
 - # of Funds based in the Global South and East: 33 (75%)
- During these two years, Prospera collectively mobilized over \$550M USD towards feminist and women's movements in 173 countries around the world.

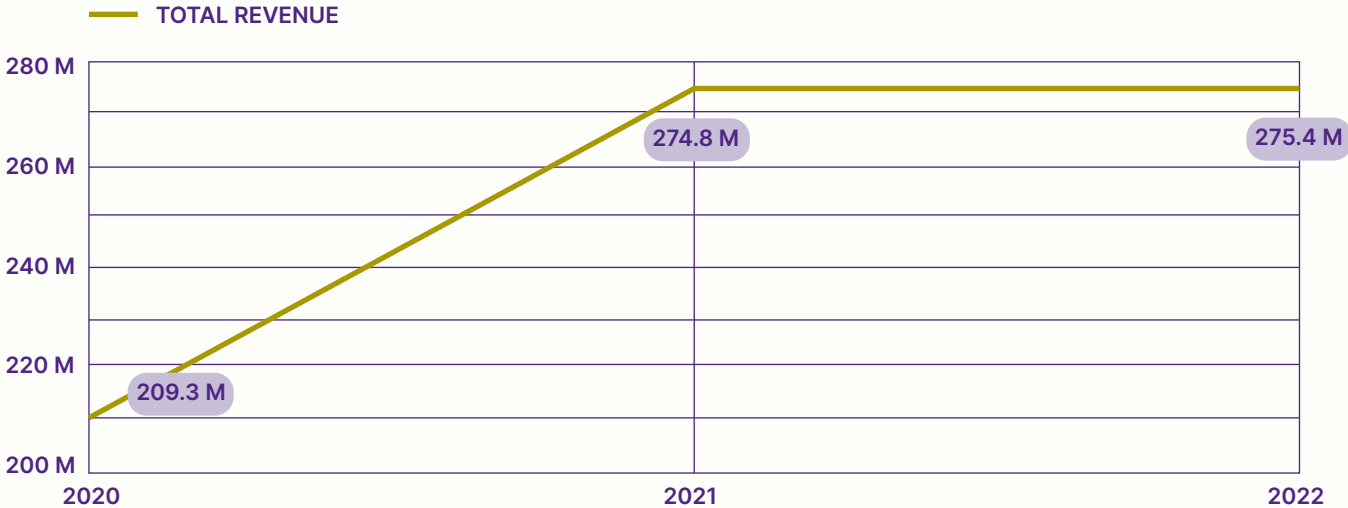
of our collective funding goes to formerly colonized territories in Latin America and the Caribbean, Asia and the Pacific, Africa, the Middle East, Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

Revenue:

Mobilizing +\$550M for women's and feminist movements around the world.

From 2020 to 2022, Prospera members have increased their revenue in 31.6%, from 209M USD in 2020 to 275M USD in 2022.

Nearly half of this growth is due to MacKenzie Scott's gifts to 21 Prospera INWF members.¹



¹ Since 2020, MacKenzie Scott has been providing unrestricted financial support totaling more than \$14 billion to more than 1,600 different organizations. Among these organizations, 22 were also members of the Prospera INWF Network.

- research and advocacy
