An overview of the 2021-2022 Women's and Feminist Funds figures.



We Are Prospera:

Prospera is a global political network of bold, intersectional, diverse, and autonomous women's and feminist funds committed to resource justice through our feminist grantmaking and advocacy work. We are a diverse and interconnected network that resources, supports, and accompanies movements led by women, girls, trans, intersex, and non-binary people, primarily in the Global South and East, as they stand at the forefront of gender, social, and environmental transformation.

Drawn from our 2021-2022 data, the following highlights illustrate the growth, impact, and reach of our network. More importantly, they invite us to envision the future: What could feminist movements accomplish if fully funded? What transformations could we achieve with complete and sustained support?

Our Collective Impact¹

Prospera members increased their revenue by 31.6%, from \$209M in 2020 to \$275M in 2022².

+38% in 2021, +56% in 2022 and 94% more Funded Programs by members over 2 years.

Over two years, Prospera members funded 94% more programs and collectively mobilized over \$550M to support feminist and women's movements in 173 countries around the world.

Our figures are based on data from 44 Prospera INWF members.

Nearly half of this growth is due to gifts from one single high net worth individual, MacKenzie Scott, to 20 Prospera INWF members and 1 to the Prospera Network.

With a strong commitment to long-term impact, women's and feminist funds support movements much beyond grantmaking. Effective movement building involves not only providing financial support but also investing in:

- · Institutional strengthening
- · Accompaniment and capacity building
- · Multiple convenings and dialogues for movement building
- Research and advocacy

Despite feminist funders' efforts, only 39% of eligible applications were funded, leaving 61% unmet—a clear reminder° of the movement's needs and the ongoing work to support intersectional gender justice activism.
